Other energy-saving procedures include: using highly insulated windows and doors; orienting the setting of the home to best utilize the sun's rays; minimizing the ratto of exterior wall to floor area to reduce the amount of area to be insulated; being sure the heating equipment is right for the home: and allowing for proper ventilation throughout the house.
